FISHER-TITUS CANCER PROGRAM

If you or a loved one is dealing with cancer, it's important you have a facility close to home that will provide everything you need for the best possible treatment, recovery and comfort.

Fisher-Titus Medical Center's Cancer Program has been Accredited by the American College of Surgeon's Commission on Cancer since 1989 assuring our patients that they are receiving the highest quality cancer care.

The Oncology & Hematology Department at Fisher-Titus serves the community with board certified physicians and experienced nurses who are specially trained in the treatment of oncology patients. Cleveland Clinic Cancer Centers-North Coast Cancer medical oncologist-hematologists and radiation oncologists are available for patient treatment and follow-up at the Fisher-Titus Cancer Care Center.



HURON COUNTY HEALTH ASSESSMENT

In 2014, **11%** of Huron County adults had been diagnosed with cancer at some time in their life, increasing to **25%** for those over the age of 65.

Of those diagnosed with cancer they reported the following types: Prostate (23%), Breast (21%), other Skin Cancer (19%), Melanoma (7%).

Huron County's Incidence of Cancer 2007-2011/All Types 1,624 cases

Prostate: 209 cases (13%) Breast: 208 cases (13%)

Colon and Rectum: 187 cases (12%)

LUNG CANCER

The leading cause of deaths in Huron County according to Huron Co. Health Assessment

Prevention: Smoking Cessation performed individually throughout the year. Participants: 61

Screenings: Low Dose Computed Tomography (CT) Scans done throughout the year.

Total Participants: 26

PROSTATE CANCER

23% of Huron County Residents have prostate cancer

Screenings: February 13, April 23, July 29, October 22.

Total Participants: 108

BREAST CANCER - 21% OF RESIDENTS

21% of Huron County Residents have breast cancer.

Only 52% of women over the age of 40 in Huron County receive mammograms as directed.

Screenings*: April 2, August 27.

Total Participants: 22

* Mammograms for the under-served and under-insured

SKIN CANCER

19% of Huron County residents report this type

Skin Cancer rates may be due to a largely agricultural area with high outdoor activity
