FISHER-TITUS CANCER PROGRAM

Fisher-Titus Medical Center's Cancer Program has been Accredited by the American College of Surgeon's Commission on Cancer since 1989 assuring our patients that they are receiving the highest quality cancer care.

The Oncology & Hematology Department at Fisher-Titus serves the community with board certified physicians and experienced nurses who are specially trained in the treatment of oncology patients. Cleveland Clinic Cancer Centers-North Coast Cancer medical oncologist-hematologists and radiation oncologists are available for patient treatment and follow-up at the Fisher-Titus Cancer Care Center.



HURON COUNTY HEALTH ASSESSMENT

In 2017, **11%** of Huron County adults had been diagnosed with cancer at some time in their life, increasing to **25%** for those over the age of 65.

Of those diagnosed with cancer they reported the following types: Skin Cancer (24%), Prostate (22%), Breast (17%), Cervical (14%), Testicular (9%), Melanoma (8%), Leukemia (6%), Bladder (5%), Colon (5%), Ovarian (3%), Renal (3%), Lung (2%), and Thyroid (2%).

Huron County's Incidence of Cancer 2010-2014, All Types 1,586 cases, with the Lung and Bronchus: 261 cases (16%)

Breast: 199 cases (13%)
Prostate: 170 cases (11%)
Colon and Rectum: 147 cases (9%)

OBESITY

Studies have shown a direct correlation between obesity and cancer risk. Huron County 2017 Health Assessment showed that two-thirds of Huron County adults were either overweight (27%) or obese (40%). Obesity has steadily increased since 2007 (34%)

BREAST CANCER

Huron County 2017 health assessment showed only 45% of women over the age of 40 had a mammogram in last year and only 65% had one in last 2 years a drop from previous years. The state and US for women having a mammogram within last 2 years was Ohio at 72% and US at 73%.

CERVICAL CANCER

According to the American Cancer Society one way to help prevent Cervical Cancer is vaccination against Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). In Huron County we have an 8.0-11.0 rate of cervical cancer with Ohio at 7.6 and U. S. at 7.4

Outreach Activity: Cervical Cancer-HPV Awareness program in local junior high and high school classes.

LUNG CANCER

The leading cause of deaths in Huron County according to Huron Co. 2017 Health Assessment at 16% of all cancers.

Prevention: Smoking Cessation information given to those interested in stopping.Screenings: Low Dose Computed tomography (CT) scans done throughout the year.

Total Participants: 66

SKIN CANCER

Activity: Skin Cancer Screening

Identified area of need: Huron County 2017 health assessment showed 24% of residents reported they had skin cancer. We are a larger agricultural community. We know that we have a large number of residents with skin cancer or the potential to have it.

Outreach Activity: Skin Cancer Screening
