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
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- Phase two of a \$6.9 million renovation project for the Main Laboratory completed.

With more than 1,200 employees, Fisher-Titus generated over \$239 million in economic impact in the three-county region. The figure includes the direct economic impact associated with hospital operations, the "ripple effect" of working with other businesses and the economic activity resulting from our employees living and working in our local communities.
