FISHER-TITUS CANCER PROGRAM

Fisher-Titus Medical Center's Cancer Program has been Accredited by the American College of Surgeon's Commission on Cancer since 1989 assuring our patients that they are receiving the highest quality cancer care.

The Oncology & Hematology Department at Fisher-Titus serves the community with board certified physicians and experienced nurses who are specially trained in the treatment of oncology patients. Cleveland Clinic Cancer Centers-North Coast Cancer medical oncologist-hematologists and radiation oncologists are available for patient treatment and follow-up at the Fisher-Titus Cancer Care Center.



HURON COUNTY HEALTH ASSESSMENT

In 2014, **11%** of Huron County adults had been diagnosed with cancer at some time in their life, increasing to **25%** for those over the age of 65.

Of those diagnosed with cancer they reported the following types: Prostate (23%), Breast (21%), other Skin Cancer (19%), Melanoma (7%).

Huron County's Incidence of Cancer 2007-2011/All Types 1,624 cases

Prostate: 209 cases (13%) Breast: 208 cases (13%)

Colon and Rectum: 187 cases (12%)

CERVICAL CANCER

According to the American Cancer Society one way to help prevent Cervical Cancer is vaccination against Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). In Huron County we have an 11.6 rate of cervical cancer with Ohio and U. S. at 7.4

Prevention: Cervical Cancer-HPV Awareness program with Nurse Practitioner at local schools.

Dates held: 10/11, 11/13, 11/14, 12/5, 12/6, 12/13, 12/15

Total Participants: 318

LUNG CANCER

The leading cause of deaths in Huron County according to Huron Co. Health Assessment

Prevention: Smoking Cessation information given to those interested in stopping.

Total Participants: 35

Screenings: Low Dose Computed tomography (CT) scans done throughout the year.

Total Participants: 49

BREAST CANCER

21% of Huron County Residents have breast cancer.

Huron County 2014 health assessment showed only 52% of women over the age of 40 get their mammogram as directed.

Screenings: Mammogram screenings for underserved or un/under insured

Dates held: 8/19, 10/7

Total Participants: 21



FISHER-TITUS PREVENTION / OUTREACH / SCREENING PROGRAMS (cont'd)

SKIN CANCER

Activity: Sun Damage Awareness

Huron County 2014 health assessment showed 19% of residents reported they had skin cancer.

We are a larger agricultural community, with high outdoor activity.

Screenings: Skin Cancer screening

Dates held: 4/1

Total Participants: 97

Outreach: Derma Scan, "See Spot" handouts

Dates held: 5/16, 7/15, 8/25, 10/15

Total Participants: 248

PROSTATE CANCER

Identified area of need: Huron County 2014 health assessment showed 13% of male residents reported they had prostate cancer with 5% of deaths.

Activity: Prostrate-PSA screens

Dates held: 4/22, 7/28, 10/21

Total Participants: 97





FISHER-TITUS PREVENTION / OUTREACH / SCREENING PROGRAMS (cont'd)

OUTREACH PROGRAMS

OBESITY has been found to be a factor in cancer incidence, walking programs held to increase activity and decrease obesity

Huron County 2014 health assessment showed 70% of adults were overweight or obese based on Body Mass Index. We know that there is a direct correlation with being overweight and developing cancer.

Activity: Walking Programs

Dates held: 1/21, 4/4, 4/11, 4/18, 4/25, 5/2, 5/6, 5/9
